

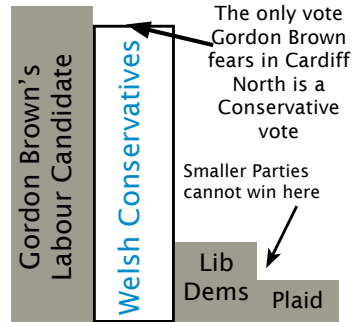

REDEDICATION OF HEATH PARK

Cllr. Ron Page and I, Cllr. Lyn Hudson, are celebrating after securing the rededication of Heath Park which has been negotiated over a long period and which brings security to a large proportion of parkland.

The original dedication document was never ratified and we have continually asked that this be rectified. The Council has entered into a fresh agreement with Fields in Trust, the trustees of Heath Park, who will have the final say on any plans for the area. This will ensure that 81

acres that have been rededicated will be protected for the residents and visitors of Heath to enjoy in the years to come.

It is the culmination of a lot of hard work by my colleague Ron Page and I. We are very delighted that we have finally made progress and secured this dedication. That does not mean that we will rest on our laurels as there are areas of Heath Park that were not included in the original dedication but we are delighted that at least some of our hard work has paid off.

Lyn was quoted as saying in the Echo article at the time "This isn't just any park. It was left in perpetuity to the citizens of Heath" and we are delighted that this has happened.

Jonathan Evans, Prospective Parliamentary Candidate, spoke of Lyn and Ron's achievement "Ron and Lyn must be congratulated for their success in delivering this massive service for future generations of Heath residents. The status of Heath Park has now been fully secured as a result of their tireless efforts."

WIDE ISSUE

Whitchurch High School continues to be in the forefront of local news with the proposed reduction of the pupil intake. This is a result of Cardiff Council's proposals to reorganise schools in Whitchurch which include the reduction of the high school

To overcome this and to enable them to continue to provide the educational opportunity to the local community they have applied for Foundation Status.

This would protect and improve the educational opportunities of the school, support staff in developing teaching and learning opportunities and it would keep the existing playing fields and facilities

This is because as a Foundation school the Governors would control the land and site and the Council could not dispose of these or the school playing fields. We sincerely hope that Whitchurch High School intake is not cut, as pupils from our catchment area could be directly affected and we give our full support to the School Governors in taking whatever measures are appropriate. The Governors of Whitchurch High School are concerned that the reduction will drastically reduce the ability of the school to provide the high quality of education currently provided and curtail for many parents and children the option of being able to attend this excellent school.

HEATHWOOD ROAD TREES

After several enquiries Cllr. Lyn Hudson has informed InTouch that Cardiff Council must consider the question of replacement tree planting. A survey of the condition of trees in this area was undertaken in the summer.

According to the Council it is not possible to accommodate the removal of stumps or replacements within this financial year and the next opportunity would occur in 2012/13 when the street tree management activities next focuses on Cardiff North. Clearly this is not acceptable and we will press the Council to bring forward the programme with a view to also looking at the diseased trees in the road. We will keep you informed of progress.

YOUTH ANNOYANCE

Incidents of youths congregating and smoking illegal substances in the gullies behind the shops in Caerphilly Road have been reported to the local Police. An update will be given at the next PACT meeting. Also reported is violence and suspected drug abuse in the lane at the back of one of the public houses in Caerphilly Road. This escalated recently into a brawl late at night and we have requested that the situation be monitored.

The next PACT meeting will be at 7pm on 14th December at Maes y Coed Community Centre, Maes y Coed Road, Heath.

LOCAL IMPROVEMENTS

There is a new sliding barrier at the entrance to the Council offices with new signage and notices giving information to visitors about parking and operating times. We have had notification that the barrier will open at 6am and close automatically at 10pm every day. In the event that emergency access is required outside of these times users have been asked to telephone the car park management company Vinci Park Cardiff Ltd on 07909 933747.

This is to inform residents of the ongoing scheme of environmental improvements in the ward with the installation of dropped kerbs at a number of locations. Also a section of footway in King George V Drive is to be renewed and we are assured that every effort will be made to ensure that any disruption to residents is kept to a minimum.
