

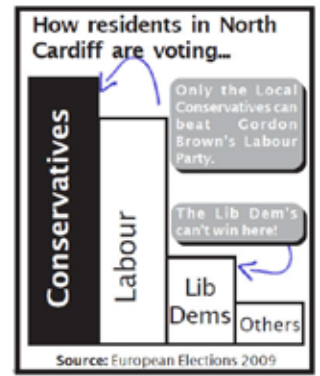

“MASSIVE REFORM OF PLANNING LAWS NEEDED”

Jonathan Evans has pledged to work for a massive reform of UK planning laws to put local communities ‘back in the driving seat’ when new development is proposed.

‘Over the summer many people in Cardiff have been alarmed to hear of proposed planning changes in our local communities. It may be true that many of these schemes will never get off the ground, but the whole procedure concerning planning decisions now lacks public confidence.

Too often, local communities are seeing their priorities over-ruled by Welsh Assembly inspectors. To add insult to injury local councillors are warned not to express opinions on development proposals on legal grounds.

All of this can unfairly undermine public confidence in locally elected representatives.

It is time to put local communities back in the driving seat when development plans are considered.

PARKING PROBLEMS

All day, on street parking near commercial centres and business parks is a problem throughout the city and Pontprennau is no exception. Whilst there has been some improvement on some streets, there are still areas where this is a problem. Residents in Heol Camddwr and Heol Glaslyn complain of obstructive parking. If this affects you, call 101.

We have discussed this problem with council officers who will contact Cardiff Gate Business Park. With joint working there has been an improvement but it is important to ensure that they are aware that it is still a problem.

Pontprennau Multi Use Games Area **UPDATE**

The top of the range Multi Use Games Area (MUGA) is now open!

An officer was sent on site to make sure everything was safe at the site and we are pleased to report that the officer inspecting found everything to be in safe and in order.

The MUGA is placed behind the Pontprennau Community Centre and although there has been a little disruption caused by losing an open football pitch for a few weeks things are looking up, the four pitches have been restored to pristine condition.

We have met with senior officers at the Council and secured the Section 106 planning gain funds making sure that all the money was kept and spent in Old St. Mellons.

We are currently meeting with Council officers to discuss funds and projects available for Pontprennau and look forward to updating you soon regarding this matter.

The next PACT meeting will be held on Thursday 29th October at 7pm in Pontprennau Community Centre. The PACT priorities set at the last meeting on the 10th September were littering and dog fouling along Almond Drive and Croescadarn Close.

Dog fouling is an offence which can attract an immediate financial penalty. It is deeply unpleasant and dangerous to health. Please ensure you clean up after your pet.
